


Step 1: Apply to WCC

Step 2: Request official transcripts form your high school and any colleges that you have attended. You do not need transcripts from any college in the VCCS. Transcripts can be sent to the addresses below: Admissions Office Wytheville Community College 1000 East Main Street Wytheville, VA 24382 admissions@wcc.vccs.edu

Step 3: Ensure you have met the program course and GPA requirements and prerequisites:		
Biology	1 unit of high school or college biology with a "C" or better	
English	Readiness for ENG 111	
Math	Competency in MDE 10	
Chemistry	1 unit of high school or college chemistry with a "C" or better	
Minimum GPA	2.5 cumulative OR 2.5 curricular GPA	

*For specific requirements please refer to the health professions grid chart.



WCC allows 3 testing attempts each year, but applicants must wait 30 days between each testing attempt.

To schedule a TEAS test, refer to the Health Professions webpage.



Step 5: Request an application code and complete the Health Professions Application.



Step 6: Submit PTA shadowing hours form available on the Health Professions webpage. You must complete 12 shadowing hours with a physical therapist or a licensed physical therapist assistant in a PT practice.

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
