Apply for Admission to WCC

Application for Dual Enrollment Students:

If you have taken dual enrollment classes while in high school, you are already considered a WCC student.

Check with Admissions at admissions@wcc.vccs.edu or 276-223-4701 to verify application status.

If your application is active, you will **only** need to complete a high school transition form instead of an application.

(Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

You will also need to complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA application.

If you are attending Fall 2024 semester, please select the 2024-2025 FAFSA application.

2023-2024 FAFSA covers Fall 2023, Spring 2024, and Summer 2024 semesters.

2024-2025 FAFSA covers Fall 2024, Spring 2025, and Summer 2025 semesters.

Final High School Transcripts will also need to be sent to the Financial Aid Office and the Admissions Office from the High School after you graduate.
