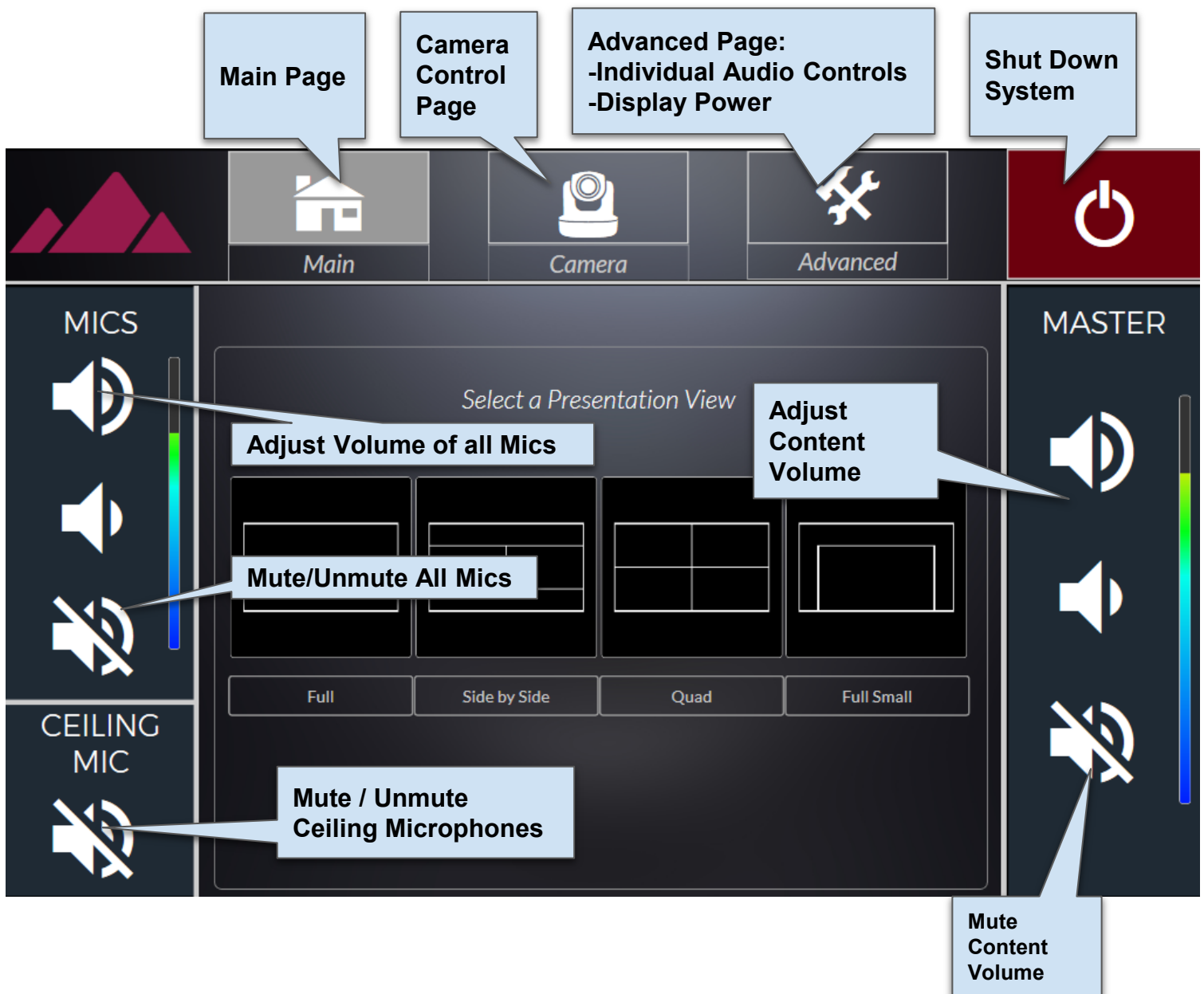


AV Operating Procedure Smyth 122

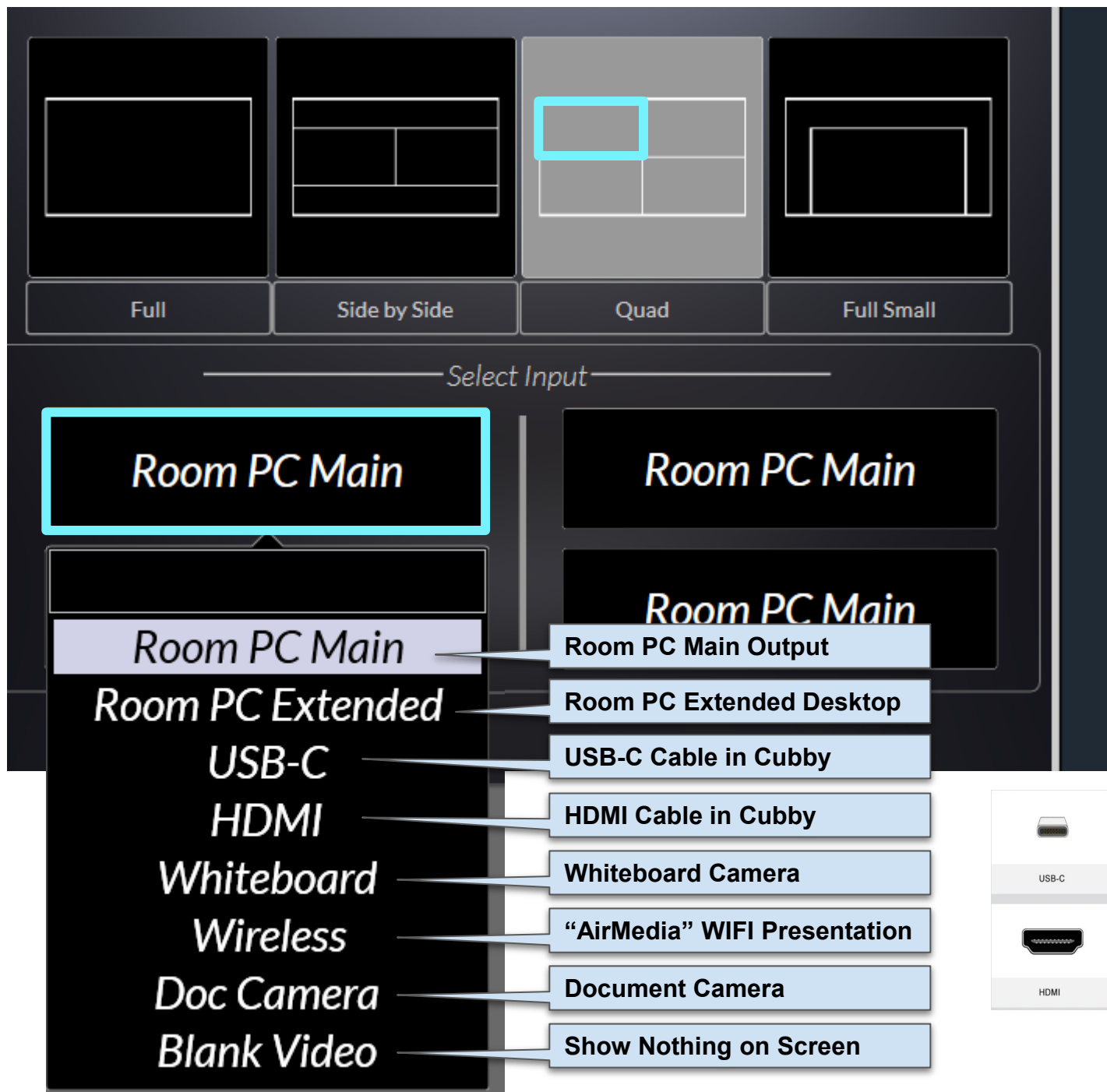
1. Turn ON the System (Press to Start)
2. If using your own laptop, connect from the cubby **EITHER:**
Both HDMI & USB-A Cables
Only the USB-C cable
3. Select the appropriate speaker/microphone settings on your laptop and in Zoom.
-Choose "Echo Canceling Speakerphone"
4. Select a "Presentation View" from the "Main" page.

Once you select a "Presentation View", touch the corresponding source locations to open up the menu to select the desired source.

*In this example of the "Quad" view, the top left source button will route the selected content to the top left window on the screen.

Camera Control
