Step 1: Apply to WCC



Step 2: Request official transcripts from your high school and any colleges that you have attended. You do not need transcripts from any college in the VCCS. Transcripts can be sent to the addresses below:

Step 3: Ensure you have met the program course and GPA requirements and prerequisites:

BIO 141	Must be completed with a "C" or better	
ENG 111	Must be completed with a "C" or better	
SDV 100	Must be completed with a "C" or better	
PSY 230	Must be completed with a "C" or better	
PHI 220	Must be completed with a "C" or better	
Math	Competency of MDE 10	
Chemistry	1 unit of high school or college chemistry with a "C" or better OR completion of BIO 141 and BIO 142 with a "C" or better	
Minimum GPA	2.0 cumulative AND 2.5 curricular GPA for prerequisites

Step 4: Prepare for and take the TEAS-VII test (**MUST** score 64% composite **AND** 45% science) WCC allows 3 testing attempts each year, but applicants must wait 30 days between each testing attempt. *(All tests must be administered in an approved testing center. Virtual test scores will not be accepted. Scores are valid for 3 years.)*
